Homebrew Competition:

The Peterson Air Force Base (AFB) Homebrew competition is an AHA/BJCP sanctioned event.

Categories accepted: All BJCP including mead and cider

Entries: Entries will be accepted Jan 25

— Feb 2, 2012. Entry fee is \$5 each and \$20 for unlimited. Make checks out to "The Peterson Club". You can only enter one beer per BJCP subcategory. Each entry consists of two (2) bottles, entry fee and an entry/recipe form. Each bottle must have a bottle ID form attached with rubber bands. Bottles must have no labels, or other identifying markings (besides the bottle ID form). Entry/recipe and bottle ID forms can be found at these websites:

Judging:

Judging will take place on Feb 11, 2012 at the club. Judging is in accordance with the BJCP guidelines.

Awards:

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals, designed just for this event, will be awarded in each category. Additionally, a best in show award for beer & a best mead/cider award will be given. All awards will be presented at the Fest on Feb 17 along with scoresheets. If you are not present, they will be mailed to you. Rocky Mountain Brewery and Pikes Peak Brewery will brew up a GABF Pro-Am for two lucky winners this year!

Homebrew/Awards Fest:

This is the fun part! Homebrew entrants, judges and stewards get into the festival for free! It's at

5:30PM on Feb 17 at the Peterson Club. \$9 for Peterson Club members, \$12 for everyone else. We are asking that all entrants bring some of their brew to share with other brewers and festival attendees. Those who bring to share get a guest in for free! Recommend you bring at least 24, 12oz bottles, a couple growlers or the keg equivalent to share on Feb 17, 2012. Ideally, it would be some of the beer you entered in the competition. You'll be serving next to some of our local micros. All brewers will be responsible for dispensing their beer to festival guests. Size of pour will be no more than 2 oz. The Peterson Club will provide booth space for each entrant to serve their beer — call the Club to let them know that you need booth space.
